

RoHS Declaration of Conformity

(Directive 2011/65/EU)

REMA hereby confirms that, according to the present state of knowledge, all products sold by REMA comply with Directive 2011/65/EU including the published Delegated Directives of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 June 2011 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

For the conformity of some products, the following listed exemptions according to Annex III of the above mentioned delegated directives are applicable:

6c.	Copper alloy containing up to 4% lead by mass	- July 21, 2024 for Category 9 Industrial Monitoring and Control Instruments and for Category 11.
